Thanks to the support of our Friends community, the 2024-2025 school year was filled with enriching, off-campus learning experiences that reminded students that the world is full of possibilities and that they deserve to be part of it.

A new enrichment opportunity this year included Witte Museum field trips for students across seven campuses, from elementary to high school. From learning about ancient art techniques to trying unfamiliar foods and seeing live animals up close, students were invited to step into new worlds.
